## \*School and Community

The Broward Virtual School (BVS) was founded in 2001 as a franchise of Florida Virtual School, by the Broward County Public School system, to meet the needs of its residents. BVS offers both a middle and high school, serving students in grades 6 - 12. The administrative building is located in the city of Davie, but students study from various locations in Broward County. Broward County residents are able to earn a standard diploma entirely online through the public school system at no extra cost. Approximately 200-300 students elect to pursue a diploma with BVS as their full time school each year. Courses are also available to current public, charter, parochial, private, and home schooled students on a part-time basis for various reasons at no cost to the resident.
